EMERGENCY RULE CLOSING ALL CITY PARKS AND RECREATION PARKS ON THURSDAY EVENINGS COMMENCING AT 9:00 PM FOR A DURATION OF 30 DAYS AND ON TUESDAY EVENING, JULY 4, 2023, COMMENCING AT 9:00 PM

B.R.C. Sections that are the subject of this Rule: Sections 1-4-6 “Emergency Rules Excepted,” and 8-3-3 “City Manager May Issue Rules, B.R.C. 1981.

1. Starting June 29, 2023, and for a duration of 30 days, all city Parks and Recreation parks will close on Thursday evenings commencing at 9:00 PM until opening the next morning at 5:00 AM; and on Tuesday evening, July 4, 2023, commencing at 9:00 PM until opening the next morning at 5:00 AM. With the exception of pedestrians and bicyclists passing through without delay, it shall be unlawful for any person, other than authorized city personnel, to go upon or remain within any park during hours of closure. These closures are necessary for the preservation of city property.
2. Closures will be posted on the city’s Parks and Recreation website.
3. To the extent only of any conflict, this Rule supersedes any conflicting Rules or parts of Rules.

*** NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC ***

Emergency Rule **1-4-6.A (23)**

As adopting authority, on June 29, 2023 the City Manager has adopted an Emergency Rule to:

close all city Parks and Recreation parks, starting June 29, 2023, for a duration of 30 days, on Thursday evenings commencing at 9:00 PM until opening the next morning at 5:00 AM; and on Tuesday evening, July 4, 2023, commencing at 9:00 PM until opening the next morning at 5:00 AM. With the exception of pedestrians and bicyclists passing through without delay, it shall be unlawful for any person, other than authorized city personnel, to go upon or remain within any park during hours of closure. These closures are necessary to preserve city property by reducing inappropriate usage.

The Adopting Authority has adopted the Emergency Rule, which is effective immediately, to protect the public health, safety or welfare to:

preserve and protect city park property from damage caused by unpermitted large gatherings, disruptive behavior, and vandalism.

You must contact Central Records at CentralRecords@BoulderColorado.gov, or 303-441-3043, to make an appointment to review this Rule or to have a copy sent to you.


