Additional Information

City of Boulder camps are licensed by the State of Colorado. Our license requires children to be at least 5 years old for Kidz Kamp, and at least 7 years old for Rez Camp by the first day they attend camp. Exceptions cannot be made.

Please be sure to have your current email address on file when you register. This will be used to send receipts, pre-camp information (sent 1 week prior to the start date of the camp), and information from ePact (required camp paperwork). **All camper paperwork must be submitted in ePACT no later than 2 weeks before your camper attends camp. If they will be bringing medications to camps, please ensure a medication authorization form and appropriate care plan signed by your camper's physician are uploaded in ePACT as well.**





Safety is our first priority. While risk is inherent in all outdoor activities, we pride ourselves on teaching campers to assess situations, use sound judgment and make good decisions as they take appropriate risks. Please note that Valmont Bike Park programs involve a higher level of risk due to the terrain and skills taught. We mitigate these risks by grouping kids and teens by experience level, requiring protective equipment, providing environmental briefings, practicing falling techniques, and challenge by choice across all elements. Valmont Bike Park Camp campers should be confident riding on two wheels (without training wheels).

- Participants will be divided into groups of 7 or less; must be able to ride 2-wheeler.
- Extended care 8 a.m–5:30 p.m. available (fees at Avid4.com). Extended care campers get extra riding time out in the park.
- Special park bikes and protective gear (required) can be rented for an additional fee.
