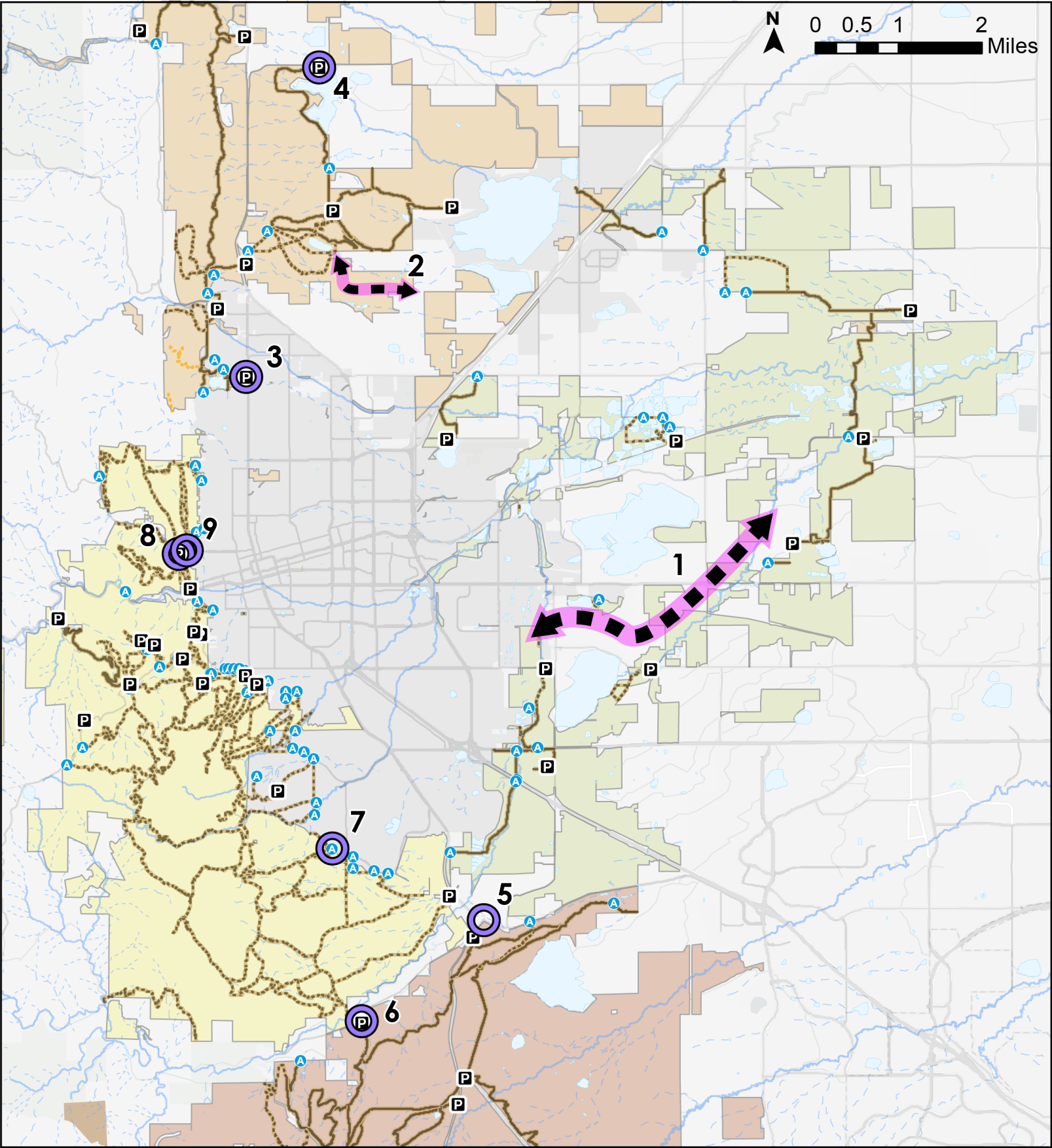




Draft Package of Multimodal Solutions

Trail Connections & Uses

- 1. Prioritize a study that evaluates the feasibility of an East Boulder Trail Corridor
- 2. Prioritize construction of the Wrangler Multi-use Connection

Trailheads & Access Points

- 3. Wonderland Lake - Prioritize construction of restrooms
- 4. Left Hand Trailhead - Design and construct a shade structure and restroom
- 5. Marshall Rd and Eldorado Springs Dr intersection - Crosswalk safety improvement
- 6. Doudy Draw Trailhead - Design and construct a shade structure and restroom
- 7. Cragmoor Connector - Install bike racks
- 8. Centennial Trailhead to Mt. Sanitas Trail - Crosswalk safety improvements
- 9. Sanitas - Vehicle congestion and trailhead improvements

- 10. Online Navigation & Routing Tool - Enhanced digital tool for finding trails
- 11. OSMP Webpage Update - Accessing OSMP trails without a personal vehicle

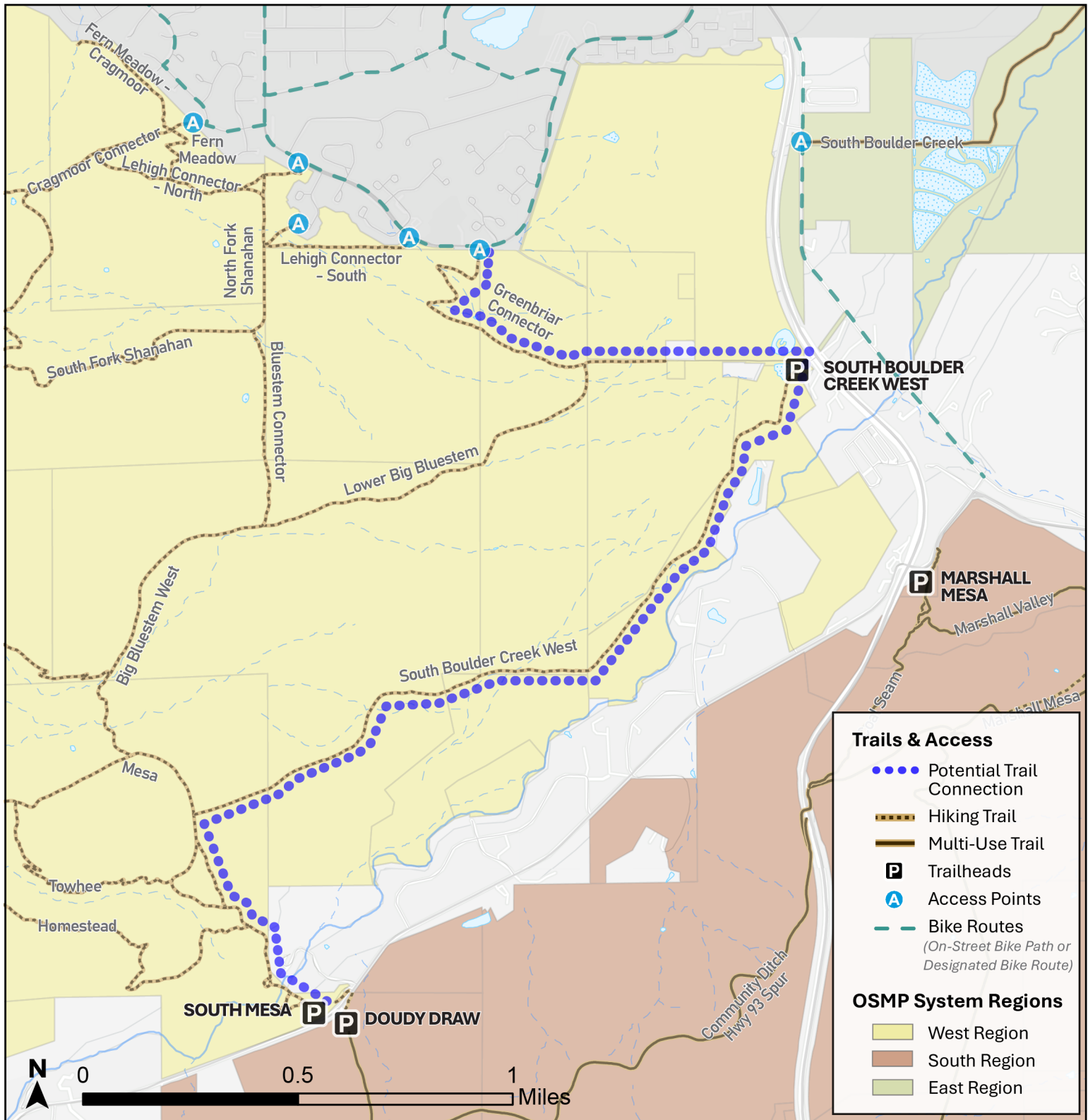

Potential Shanahan-Doudy Draw Trail Connection



This potential trail connection would plan to reroute portions of existing trails to create a continuous multi-use route built to OSMP bike design standards. The connection would begin at the **Greenbriar Connector**, follow **Thomas Lane** to the **South Boulder Creek West Trail**, and continue south along the **Mesa Trail** to the **South Mesa** and **Doudy Draw** Trailheads.

While a potential approach for how a southwest bike trail connection could be made is presented here, no recommendation has been made regarding whether it should be included in the Multimodal Assessment Project's final recommendations. Community feedback will help inform the next steps and any future recommendation.
