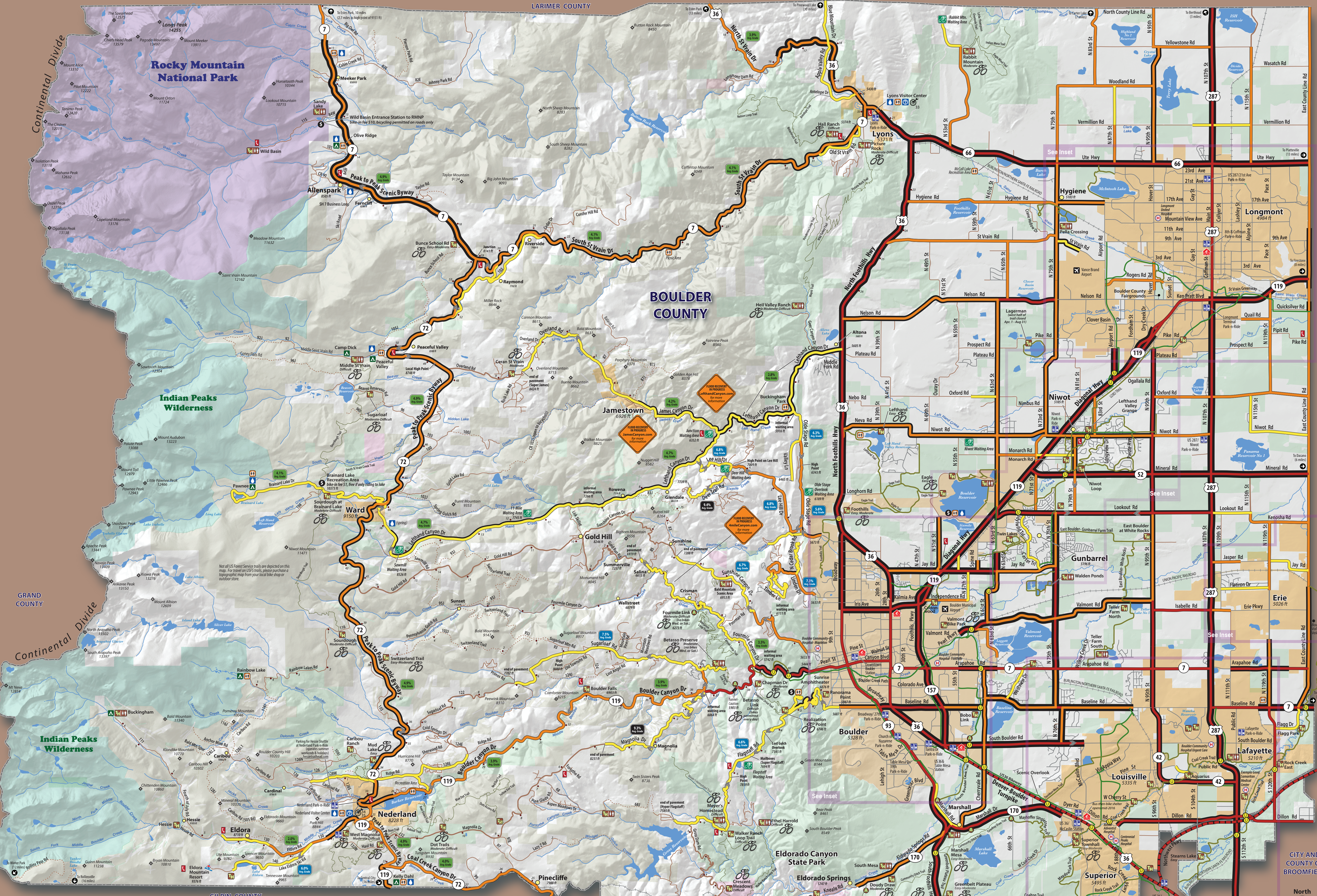

- slowing down

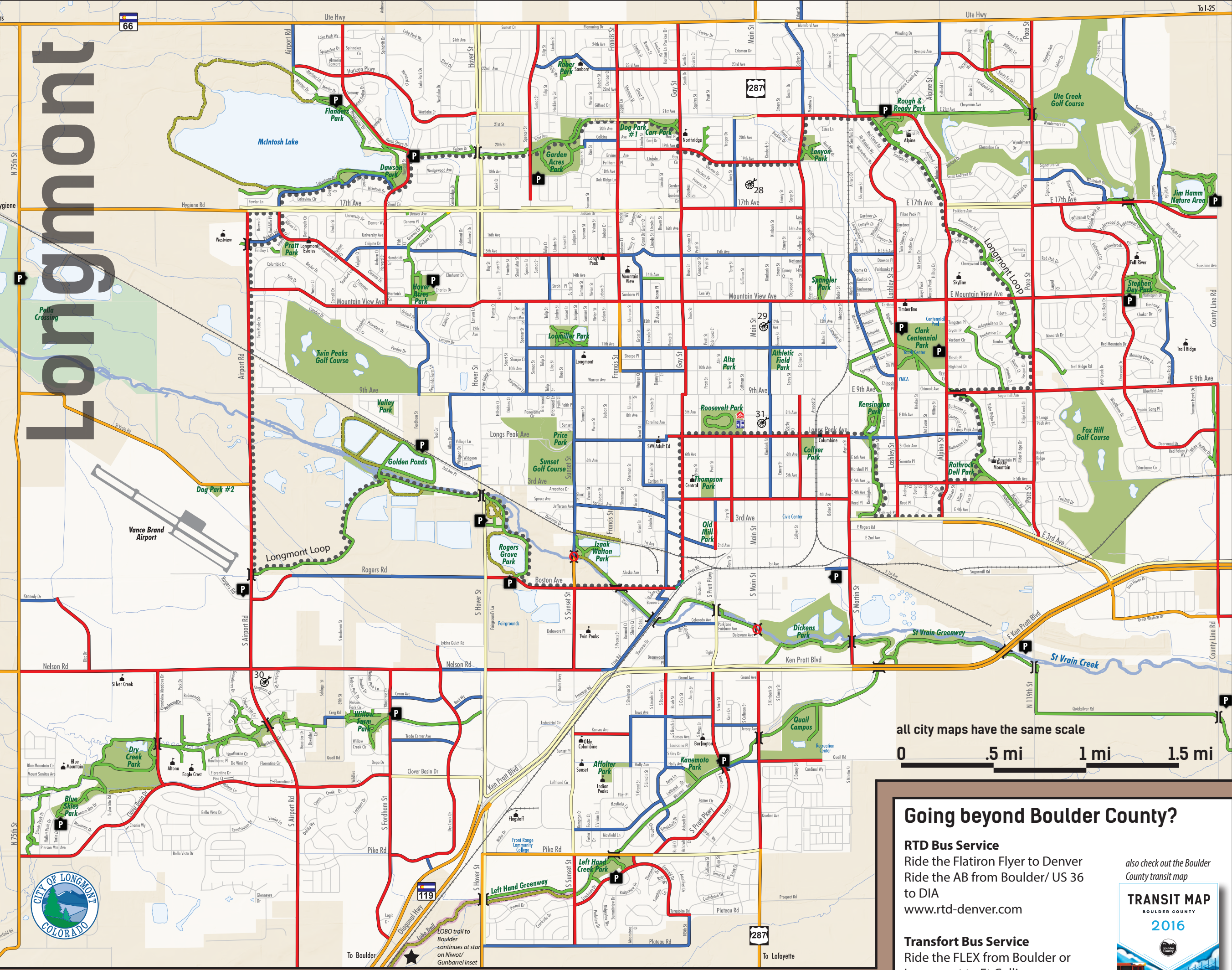
Be cautious when riding two abreast

Bike-n-Ride

- Signal to the bus driver that you are loading your bike
- You must be able to lift your bike and place it on the rack yourself
- Stay near the front of the bus and watch your bike to ensure its safety
- Exit the front door and remind the driver you are removing your bike
- If you are the last person to unload your bike, fold rack upright
- All RTD buses (except for the 16th St MallRide) are equipped with bike racks on the front of the bus.

RTD is not responsible for lost or stolen bikes or damage to bikes due to improper loading.

- Squeeze handle to release the rack
- Lower the rack
- Place front wheel on side labeled "front wheel"
- Pull support arm over the wheel

Regional Bus Bike Loading

- Remain in line when the bus arrives.
- Always allow the driver to open and close the luggage bin.
- Return to your place in line after compactly loading your bicycle.
- When exiting the bus tell the driver you need to collect your bike.
