than 5:00 p.m. on the day prior to the meeting or noon on the day of the meeting, if the day prior to the meeting is a city holiday, the city clerk shall post on the internet a list of no more than twenty individuals who will be invited to speak at the meeting. If more than twenty people register to speak, the city clerk shall select twenty names at random from among those who have registered.
