

Broadway Reconstruction: Violet to US36

Project Scope and Funding

Project Purpose

The project will reconstruct the existing asphalt pavement with concrete pavement from south of Violet to north of Lee Hill Road. Asphalt mill and overlay will be provided north of Lee Hill Road to US 36 (scope adjustment due to funding). The project will provide a more durable pavement that does not require as frequent maintenance and provides a safer and better riding experience for drivers, transit riders and street bicyclists.

Funding

- Original Project Budget = \$8.3M (design/construction/ROW - Easement Acquisition)
 - \$2.075M - City Transportation Funding
 - \$6.225M - Federal Transportation Improvement Project (TIP) grant awarded in the Roadway Reconstruction Project category
- Additional city utilities funding for new drainageway structure/underpass at Fourmile Canyon Creek

Project Scope

- Reconstruction of Broadway from Violet to US36, including new curb and gutter
- Installation of on-street buffered bike lanes
- New traffic signal at Yarmouth Avenue and improvements to existing traffic signals
- Strategic pedestrian and transit stop upgrades where feasible
- New drainageway structure/underpass improvements at Fourmile Canyon Creek
- Some city utility upgrades (storm sewer south of Fourmile Canyon Creek, city backbone fiber)
