- Proposal submission deadline: August 10
- Agency interviews: September 13-14
- Deliberations meetings: October 2-4

Follow-up: HEAC members will contact staff with any schedule conflicts for key meeting dates.

<u>Proposal Evaluation Criteria</u>. Presentation and discussion of draft criteria to include in the Request for Proposals, and for consideration for proposal ranking, weighting, and allocation recommendations. HEAC members provided feedback and suggestions for staff consideration.

<u>Target Programs and Outcomes</u>. Discussion about target populations, programs and outcomes, for strategic focus and impact of HEF funds. HEAC member recommendations include:

- Funding scope that includes broader health equity programming, not limited to SSB programs;
- Program priorities that could include:
 - o disease prevention (including healthy food and safe water access/nutrition, physical fitness, etc.);
 - o health services;
 - o research;

- o integration of services; and
- o innovative health equity programs.
- Evaluation metrics for short-, intermediate- and long-term health outcomes, for the 2019 fund round and/or for future fund rounds.

Follow-up: Staff will share the final draft RFP with HEAC members and accept feedback before finalization. Staff will also consider HEAC input for development of the funding application.
