Arrival: Reference your ticket for arrival time. Park forward facing and so there is one space between vehicles. Event staff will help direct you to the appropriate parking space based on your vehicle's height.

Departure: Exit by pulling forward and to the left to facilitate a quick exit. If you need to leave before the movie ends, please text 303-483-5003 so we may assist you safely and with minimal disruption.

Turn Off Car and Headlights: Engine idling is not permitted. Please dress accordingly and bring extra clothing or blankets to keep warm during the movie.

Sound and Radio: Audio will be broadcast via FM radio in your vehicle on 90.5 FM. Please use accessory mode (most newer vehicles can press the power button once without pressing brake pedal to start accessory mode). You are also allowed to bring a portable FM radio.

Food and Beverage: You are welcome to bring your own food and non-alcoholic beverages. Pre-wrapped treat bags will be provided directly upon check-in (before the movie begins). One bag will be provided per guest upon check-in. Allergen information will be provided on each item inside bag.

Seating: You may choose to stay in your car or bring your own chairs and sit in the vacant parking space adjacent to your car. To ensure screen visibility for all guests, lift gates / trunks may not be left open. Masks are not required inside your vehicle; however, masks should be worn when within off of people not in your household.

Restrooms: Restrooms are available and located towards the east side of the movie screen. Physical distancing with those not in your own household is required. Masks must be worn when going indoors to use the restroom.

Battery: If your battery dies, you can text event staff at 303–483–5003. We have an emergency jump box available. This is a courtesy service, and we are unable to jump vehicles until the movie ends.
