Equity: Daycares & schools are one story, plus mobile home parks in floodplains

All schools in this area are one story, so there's nowhere for them to go. Crestview would be totally inaccessible if creeks on both sides flood.

Equity issue with affordable housing being placed in hazardous areas prone to flooding.

City could implement its own insurance program to assist vulnerable areas (i.e. mobile home estates) City maybe able to get better coverage. Falling water & Flood insurance.

Natural flood mitigation: small channel for low flows, benches where flood waters can spread out with natural open areas.

Natural, environmental solutions that are cheaper - weighing the natural solutions against "built" engineered solutions.

Some of the lowest economic areas were impacted and didn't have the resources to recover. Insurance coverage was little to non-existent.

When conveyance is increased in channels not equitable to increase volume or velocity on downstream recipients.
