Budget Narrative

CITY OF BOULDER POLICE DEPARTMENT: allocated \$22,435 for the following:

This grant will assist the Boulder Police Department in funding equipment purchases that will enhance the department’s ability to prevent and reduce crime while maintaining the officer’s safety. The University of Colorado is within the city limits of Boulder. The Boulder Police Department provides coverage for large events such as the Boulder Boulder, ProCycling and the Triathlon. The department has also been involved with the 2013 flood and the continuing risk of wildfires. The purchase of the following equipment will enhance the department’s ability to respond appropriately while maintaining the safety of both the community and the officers involved.

EQUIPMENT

Patrol Shields/Body Bunkers - \$11,770 grant amount with a city match of \$1,397. The Boulder Police Department will purchase nine replacement shields/body bunkers due to deterioration of current equipment which is, in addition, past its expiration date. Purchase price for these shields is approximately \$1,463 each. These shields allow officers an additional level of protection while trying to safely deescalate volatile situations.

SUPPLIES

Cellebrite UFED Touch 2 to Access Digital Data and Online Certification - \$10,665 grant amount. The Boulder Police Department will use this funding to purchase a one-year subscription and online certification training for the UFED Touch 2 to lawfully access digital-device data. The subscription includes Phone Detective, Logical and Physical Analyzer. Information from cell phone downloads has become increasingly important in police investigations and all levels of policing. This equipment/software/training will lessen the burden on computer forensics labs and provide real time evidence collection and review, which in turn will lead to critical cases being solved faster and increase the safety of the community. The department will continue to fund the subscription annually as departmental budget allows. Subscription cost is \$7,375 and online certification is \$3,290.

LONGMONT POLICE DEPARTMENT: allocated \$34,504 for the following:

Longmont Ending Violence Initiative (LEVI)

This grant will partially fund coordinator and program costs for the City of Longmont’s Longmont Ending Violence Initiative (LEVI). Domestic violence (DV) is an insidious crime that commands more and more time, personnel, and financial assistance from the Longmont Police Department. It continues to be the number one crime in Longmont, with cases increasing yearly. LEVI plays an integral part in the community’s efforts to address the occurrences of domestic violence in the Longmont community. Only one identified domestic violence related death has occurred since the inception of this program in 1999. Many victims, family, and friends depend upon these services.

This initiative encompasses three main goals:

- activities for domestic violence prevention/education;
- domestic violence public information; and
- easy access to domestic violence services.

Funding will be used for the following:

PERSONNEL

Project Coordinator - The grant will cover 28.5% of two ¾-time project coordinators (approximately 445 hours each annually) including 7.65% in fringe benefits (Social Security and Medicare). The coordinators will manage, coordinate, and evaluate the implementation of the LEVI Program. Total cost for personnel is \$32,510.
