## 1. License Plates

Ensure you have unexpired license plates on the front and back of your vehicle.

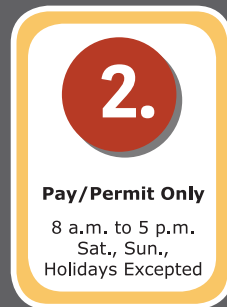


## Increasing Compliance for Safer Streets

Starting on Jan. 1, 2022 the base fine amount for most violations will be raised to \$30. The graduated fine system will increase the fine amount for each additional violation (up to the 3rd violation within one year). Mobility safety violations (parking violations that result in decreased safety/access for anyone who needs access to our public spaces) will result in an automatic \$60 fine. 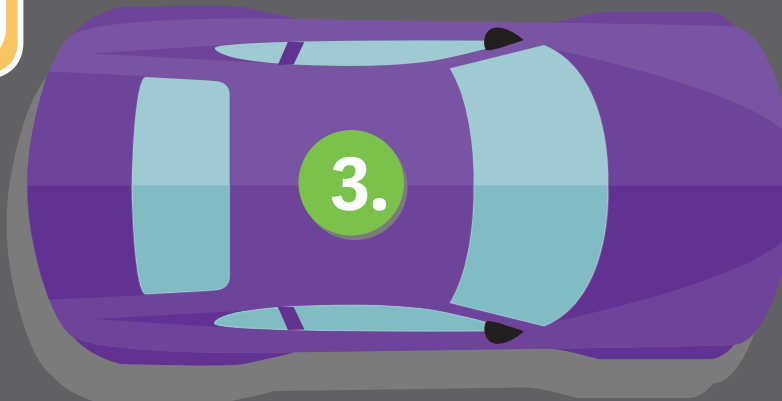
## 2. Pay / Permit Parking

Always look at signs to determine if permits are needed or payment is required.



## 3. Street Parking

Don't leave your vehicle parked too long in one space on the street: no vehicle shall be parked on any city street for more than three days without being moved. No camper, motor home, or trailer shall be parked on any city street. (For exceptions, contact City of Boulder enforcement at 303-413-7300)



## 4. Distance from driveways, fire hydrants, stop signs

Don't park too close to driveways (5 ft), fire hydrants (5 ft), crosswalks (20 ft), or traffic devices (30 ft).



## 5. Any Parking

If it's time to move your vehicle, make sure you move it at least 1056 ft. (2/10 of a mile)
