Powered Watercraft 50-499 HP	\$580	\$700	No Entrance Included
Powered Watercraft 1-49 HP & Sailboats	\$250	\$300	No Entrance Included
Small Watercraft (SWC)	\$55	\$65	No Entrance Included
Weekday Boat Permit - Allows watercraft access to the Reservoir Mon-Fri only, EXCLUDING holidays.			
Powered Watercraft 50-499 HP	\$310	\$370	No Entrance Included. Only allows for use of watercraft on weekdays, excluding holidays.
Small Watercraft (SWC)	\$35	\$40	No Entrance Included. Only allows for use of watercraft on weekdays, excluding holidays.
Watercraft Storage Options - Assigned spot storage of watercraft 1/1/2023 - 12/31/2023. Must have season permit to store watercraft on site. Only watercraft and trailers are permitted to be stored in assigned space.

	Resident	Non-Resident	**NO fuel is allowed to be stored on site or in your parking space. Any additional items must be stored on trailer or in your watercraft. Reservoir staff will complete weekly storage inspections and removal of unauthorized items beginning on April 1, 2023.
Wet Mooring	\$846	\$1058	Watercraft stored on water, assigned buoy May 15, 2023 until October 1, 2023. Dry trailer storage included 1/1/2023 - 12/31/2023. Boats must be removed from water by October 1, 2023 or a daily fee will be assessed.
Dry Paved lot	\$719	\$900	Watercraft are stored on trailers in assigned parking spots. Only boats and trailers are permitted in space.
Dry Gravel lot	\$634	\$792	
Rack Storage	\$287	\$360	All small watercraft stored on site must be kept in rack storage. Up to 2 SUP's per space - additional \$50 fee for 2nd craft applicable. No other items (including PFD or paddles) may be stored on site or attached to the rack.
